



Dear Parents/Guardians,

Although we have started a new school year the reality of COVID has not completely gone away. The Calhoun County Public Health Department (CCPHD) guidelines state that a COVID positive person must be isolated for 5 days. After the 5 days they may return to school with a mask on days 6 through 10. A more in-depth look at the guidelines can be found at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/isolation.html>. Contact tracing is no longer required by the CCPHD.

If you do test positive we ask that you share the information, along with a picture of the test results labeled with name and date, with Nurse Lebron so the positive case can be added to the CCPHD database. The CCPHD will be monitoring school districts to ensure there are no breakouts within a district. This is in line with other communicable diseases the CCPHD monitors.
