- 1. <u>105 and 105c</u>- HCS will participate in Schools of Choice for 105 and 105c for the 2022-2023 school year. Section 105 schools of choice program provides students with the option to enroll in another school district that is within the Calhoun ISD. Section 105c schools of choice program provides students with the option to enroll in a school district that is within another intermediate school district, but hares a boundary line with the Calhoun ISD.
 - Important- A cooperative agreement between HCS and the resident district regarding the payment of added cost for programs and services will be needed for all special education 105c student applicants. <u>Under no circumstances will a special education 105c student be accepted until this cooperative agreement is in place</u>. I have special education 105c agreements where the resident district pays all of the costs, where HCS pays all of the cost, and where the two districts split the cost.
- 2. <u>Schools of choice renewals</u>- School of Choice renewals will be completed as part of the student emergency form that all parents complete each fall. This is the same way that we used last fall.
- 3. <u>First Semester-</u> Schools of Choice for 1st semester will be based on unlimited positions available for enrollment. The enrollment period for new schools of choice students for the 1st semester is June 21 August 26, 2022. All forms for new schools of choice students must be dated during this enrollment period. Students can be accepted as applications are received when using unlimited positions available for enrollment.

2022-2023 Schools of Choice Semester Enrollment for New Students

- June 21 August 26, 2022 enrollment period.
- Last day for schools of choice students to enroll on August 26.
- All schools of choice students need to be enrolled and attendance taken by August 26.
- 4. <u>Second Semester</u> Schools of Choice enrollment dates will be scheduled once we have a district calendar in place that shows the date for the end of the 1st semester.
