Dear LFE Families,

I hope you are all staying safe and healthy during this challenging and uncertain time! All of us at LFE miss you and your child immensely, and we are eager for the time when it is safe to be together again! The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our Continuity of Learning Plan. While it is not ideal, our district has worked hard to bring you an awesome plan for continuing your child's learning at home!

We have purchased a program for our students called Think Stretch. This program consists of workbooks that cover math, writing, and reading. These workbooks will be mailed directly to your home, and they will also come with a parent guide to assist you in the use of the program. In addition to the workbooks, your child will receive a Daily Learning Planner with social-emotional activities. This planner is full of daily extension activities that you and your child can choose from to help encourage social-emotional learning and physical activity. We are recommending choosing one activity per day to complete with your child. They are family-centered and help to reinforce social, emotional, and physical health.

These two items, the workbook and Daily Learning Planner, are the main focus of our at-home learning. In addition to these two items, we will have resources available online, including a suggested weekly schedule created by teachers to follow. This will include information on what to do, how much time to spend on it, and what resources you'll need. This and other resources will be found online in a Google Folder that will be shared on our district website. When you access this Google Folder, you will also find lessons recorded by teachers, any materials you need, and teacher contact forms.

In addition to grade level resources on Google, you will also have access to calendars with activities and videos for your child in the areas of art, PE, and music. Special education students will also have access to additional resources in our Google Folder, in addition to having material mailed home.

Due to this specialized form of learning, there will be no final report cards, but teachers will be communicating and confirming participation during this time. All students will be promoted to the next grade level unless retention was discussed with your child's teacher during conferences in February and March.

We appreciate your support and patience as we navigate distance learning. Please reach out to me or your child's teacher with any questions you may have!
