The Homer Community Schools District is requesting bids to expand the existing high school track in accordance with the enclosed specifications and instructions. Sealed bids will be accepted at the Central Office addressed to:

Mr. Michael Leskowich , 403 S. Hillsdale St, Homer MI 49245 no later than 3:00 p.m., on Friday, October 22, 2021. No email, oral, telephonic or facsimile proposals will be accepted. Please mark on the outside of the envelope **"Track Bid"**. All bids shall be valid for not less than 90 days from the due date. The bid opening meeting will be conducted at Central Office at 403 S. Hillsdale Street, Homer MI 49245 at 3:01 p.m. on Friday, October 22, 2021.

Homer Community School District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive omissions, regularities or clerical errors not affecting substantial compliance with the plans and specifications.

The track is available for inspection Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. upon appointment. Please report to the Central Office (517-724-9331) upon entering the building.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS:

Work shall include labor and materials to:

- a) Provide site prep and excavation
- b) Provide appropriate amounts of sand and gravel to create the foundation of the track.
- c) Provide drainage to the site as needed.
- d) Widen the track to an overall track width of 29 feet.
- e) Prepare and repair existing track as needed to receive asphalt.
- f) Pave the entire track in finish grade asphalt- creating a level surface between the existing track and addition.
- g) Remove and dispose of all unused materials.
- h) Obtain all required applications and permits as needed.
- i) Warranty the installation for a period of not less than two years from date of installation.
- j) A sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) of, or any employee of, the Bidder and any member of the Board of Education or the Superintendent shall accompany ALL proposals. The owner will not accept a proposal that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.
- k) A sworn and notarized Affidavit of Compliance for the Iran Economic Sanctions Act certifying the contractor does and will comply with Public Act 517 of 2012 shall accompany ALL proposals. The owner will not accept a proposal that does not include a sworn and notarized Affidavit of Compliance for the Iran Economic Sanctions Act.
- l) Insurance Certificates and Bonds: Prepare written information indicating current status of insurance or bonding coverage. Include name of entity covered by insurance or bond, limits of coverage, amounts of deductibles and term of the coverage. 5% bond/certified check due at time of bid.

Work will be coordinated between the Superintendent and the contractor.

2. Pave 1 ½" 36A wearing course

SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Removal of Rubberized Coating on existing running track and properly dispose of materials.

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2. Remove old asphalt.
3. Prep and grade area surrounding track size 9' ft additional
4. Pave 2 ½" 13 leveling course
5. Pave 1 ½" 36A wearing course
6. Compaction with heavy-duty vibratory roller(s).
7. Install new rubberized coating.
8. Striping of track lanes.
9. Remove and re-pave long jump areas.
10. Repave/recoat high jump area.
11. Relocate surrounding drains.
